Online Learning System to mitigate COVID-19

On April 7, Japanese Government declared a state of emergency for Hyogo and six other prefectures in Japan over COVID-19 outbreak. Responding to the statement, University of Hyogo is temporarily closed until 5/6.

In relation to this measure, the University is going to review its face-to-face classroom style and will introduce online learning system after classes resume.

For the smooth transition, we kindly ask you to manage your own settings and make yourselves ready to take classes online.

1 Usage of “Universal Passport”

Please get yourselves familiar with “Universal Passport”, the exclusive portal for students and professors of our University. Use your ID and password in order to access “Universal Passport”.

2 Preparing device / peripheral equipment etc.

Followings are essential to take online classes:

- Internet-enabled technology device : Mobile device, a laptop or desktop computer. Using a device with big monitor is highly recommended.
- Peripheral equipment (If your device is not equipped with followings):
Web camera, microphone, speaker, and headphone/headset

- Live-streaming classes or on-demand classes require high speed (approx. 500MB-1GB per class). Please check your computer speed and processor as well as internet setting and make sure there will be constant access to the internet and the capacity is unlimited/big enough to take online classes.
